Pancakes for Port Au Prince , Haiti

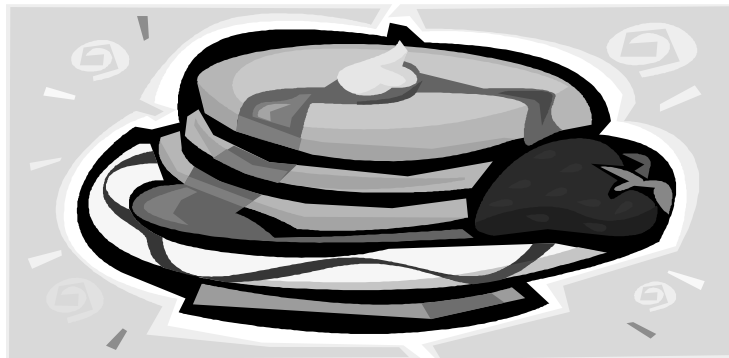
Includes: Pancakes, Scrambled eggs, Sausage, Doughnut holes, coffee, tea and juice.
