

Camp Goals:

The Cougar Soccer Camp is designed to develop soccer players to learn their full potential and thus work to that potential. Throughout the week, campers will focus on the fundamentals of the game. Each camper is given the opportunity to compete in an organized environment that is suitable to their age and/or skill level.

Camp Co-Directors:

Andrew Ganzzermiller, the Head men’s soccer coach, is an elementary school graduate (‘97) and High School graduate (‘01) who works full time in the elementary school as the Physical Education Teacher. He is a former three-sport athlete at Mount Carmel who went on to Goucher College and lettered in soccer for 4 years under coach Gary Dunda. Coach Ganzzermiller will be entering his 6th season as the varsity coach. Also, two members of the High School staff will be joining this year’s camp. Assistant coach Cornileison will be working and leading instruction.

Joining the camp from the women’s High School staff is Head Coach Jon Schneehagen. He will be entering his 3rd year of coaching the women’s Varsity team. Coach Schneehagen played four years at Villa Julie College. He is also a graduate of Mt. Carmel Elementary School .

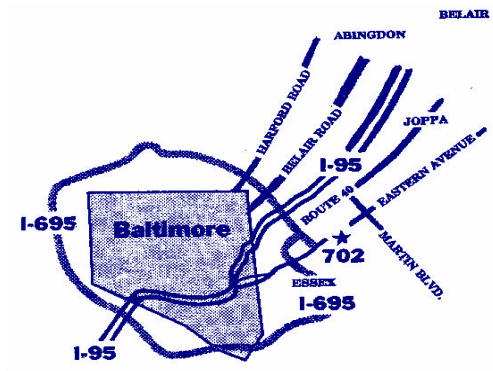
